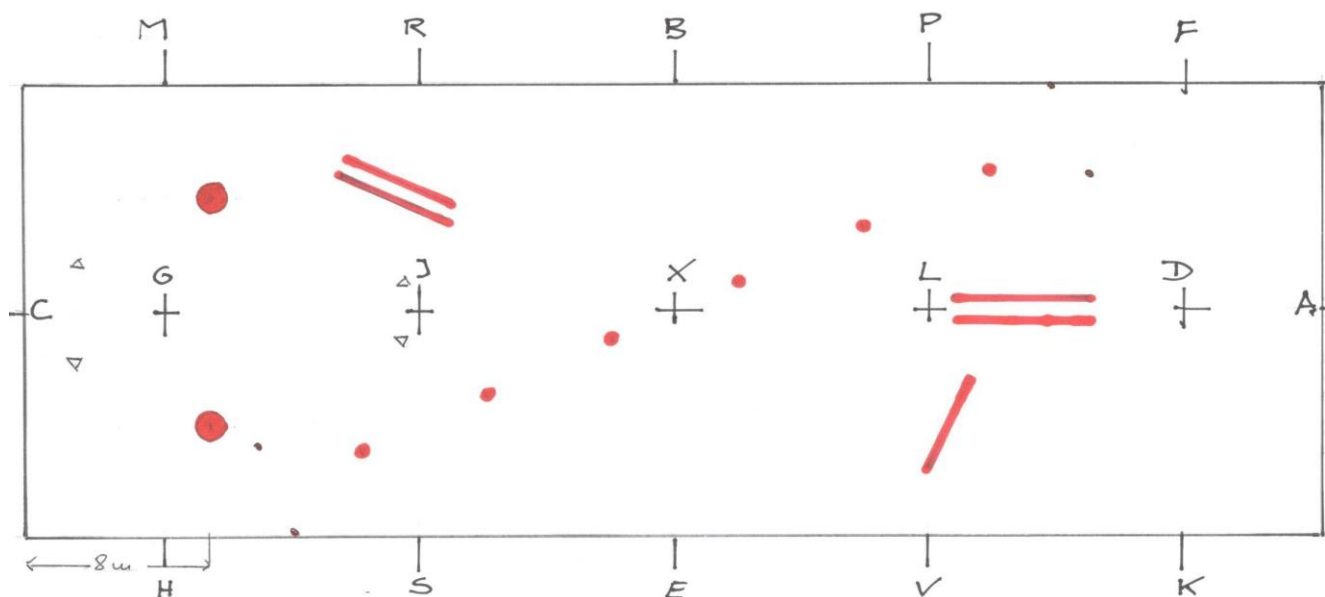

Notes on D-TREC

In addition to the D-TREC rules published with the schedule, please note:

1. The TREC marks will be added to the Dressage marks.
 - Maximum mark for each obstacle is “7”. The style is marked by the dressage judge and there is no choice of gait.
 - Faults and penalties are deducted from the maximum mark.
 - Example: The rider has touched a pole once at the slalom: “3” points are deducted from the “7” points and she/he gets a “4”.
 - If a rider does not do the obstacle in the gait asked, she/he will be marked with a “0”.
2. When riding the 20m circles, the 4 inner poles of the slalom are within the 20m circle.
3. The One Handed Figure of Eight and the Slalom will have entry and exit flags.
4. In the Open test, the Mounting with a mounting block is penalised with 2 points by the TREC judge, but the rider may step out of the circle.
5. The rider must inform the TREC Judge if she/he requires a mounting block.
6. A rider not wanting to do an obstacle must stop in front of the TREC judge and inform her/him before starting the test.
7. As most riders will not be familiar with a 20x60 arena, the tests may be called out without marks deducted.
